- Next year: adjust the font on the cost as there was some confusion abut the price of pizza

- Suggestions:
 - Game nights, cultural events, bring back Mission Day, bake sales (around Christmas or meet the teacher night)
 - All asked for more info to be sent to families
- o Eric to reach out those that participated and offer them to participate in parent council
- Discussion about the use of Survey Monkey there is a cost so we need to be mindful about what it is we want to ask/how we will use the results – perhaps consider this in June at the end of the year BBQ to ask about priorities for next year; further brainstorming to continue

Spook-a-thon Planning

- Fundraising/pledge sheets have gone home and we request that families do ONE Cash On Line deposit for this (some money has come in so far)
- Prefer to not give tax receipts but if someone really insists, we can make it work (there is a lot of clerical work to provide tax receipts, so Andrea is able to do it if requested)
- Andrea leaving the donation allowance on Cash-On-Line until end of November in case there are late supporters
- Krista and Staff to set schedule for each class/grade for the day and will give this
 to Melanie to ensure that music is prepared (Krista to have LEAD team to speak
 with classes about preferences/play lists)
- Melanie is providing a DJ service for the day
- We will order FingerLights (Cheryl can take care of this); approx. \$200 cost (approved by group and vote majority)
- \$10 gift cards to be drawn from each class (J&J Games, Dollarama for a total of \$190); Cheryl will also organize this
- Melanie to be at the event for the day and Cheryl to determine if she also comes for part of the day
